MARCH 26 – PRESENTATION OF “HISPANIC ORIGINS OF OREGON” AT THE SITE MUSEUM BODEGA Y QUADRA IN LIMA

“Hispanic Origins of Oregon” is the first academic work of the Pacific Northwest produced entirely in Spanish. Born from the collaboration between Hispanic and Native American communities, this work significantly contributes to the cultural and historical empowerment of the Spanish-speaking community in the United States. The publication redefines the historical narrative of the Northwest, highlighting the central role of Hispanics who, from Mexico, journeyed to what are now the states of Oregon and Washington.

It presents over 250 years of little-known history, the ethnic diversity of expedition teams, and accounts of the exploration of the Pacific coast—with special emphasis on the legacy of the Peruvian sailor Juan Francisco de la Bodega y Quadra.

Featuring the participation of Olga Gutiérrez Rodríguez, Jaime Marroquín Arredondo (WOU), David G. Lewis (PSU), and representatives of OCI, the Government of Peru, the Municipality of Lima, the State of Oregon, Spain, Mexico, and the United States.

MARCH 27 – PRESENTATION “FROM LIMA TO THE NORTH: NAVIGATORS AND ROUTES OF THE REAL COIN”

“From Lima to the North: Navigators and Routes of the Real” is an academic event that explores the historical significance of Lima’s navigators in the routes of the Northern Pacific and the influence of the Hispanic peso on the global economy. Through presentations by renowned historians, the event will examine the contributions of Peruvian sailors such as Juan Francisco de la Bodega y Quadra and Manuel Quimper, the connection between the maritime regions of Callao and San Blas, and the impact of the “real de a ocho” as the first global currency and a precursor to the United States dollar.

As in previous international presentations in Mexico and Spain, OCI is accompanied by a Cultural Delegation in Lima. Their presence highlights the commitment to promoting cultural diversity and strengthening Hispanic identity, reflecting the dynamic legacy shared among our peoples.

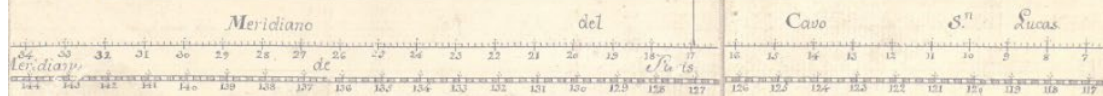
